

# UK: Inver House introduces 16 Year Old AnCnoc vintage

[Inver House](#) has announced that its 16 Year Old AnCnoc Single Malt Scotch [Whisky](#) will launch later this month into "key international markets".

The company said today (25 January) that the 16 Year Old line extension, which was hand-selected by master distiller Stuart Harvey, has been wholly matured in American Oak casks. The unchill-filtered, non-coloured single malt will join the AnCnoc range, which also includes the limited edition 12 Year Old and 30 Year Old vintages.

AnCnoc brand manager, Elaine Mitchell said: "This is a really exciting addition to the range. Our 16 year old is quite different to anything else that we've produced previously and the initial feedback we've received from connoisseurs who have tried it is very encouraging."

Bottles of the 16 Year Old have been released to select markets globally and will retail at GBP39.99 (US\$79).

Inver House is headquartered near Airdrie and has distilleries in Pulteney, Balblair, Speyburn, Knockdhu and Balmenach producing whisky brands including Old Pulteney, Balblair Single Malt Whisky, AnCnoc and Speyburn.
